
NRMCA'S INDUSTRY-WIDE EPD v3.0

NRMCA is planning to **renew** the NRMCA Industry-Wide Environmental Product Declaration (**IW**-EPD) for Concrete in 2019. **Respond by January 31, 2019.**

For those of you not familiar with what an EPD is, think of it as a nutrition label for a product; but instead of providing information such as calories, fat content and carbohydrates, an EPD provides information about environmental impacts such as global warming potential, smog formation and water use. EPDs are third party verified, or certified reports published by product manufacturers that provide quality assured and comparable information regarding environmental performance of their product.



WHY v3.0?

Due to green building standards driving environmental disclosure, NRMCA published several versions of an Industry-Wide EPD in 2014 and again in 2016. In total, 88 companies representing 2,519 plants participated. However, many members did not participate in either version and indicated they should have. NRMCA will renew the industry's IW-EPD for Concrete to give those companies the opportunity to participate. Version 3.0 will also provide an opportunity to those companies who purchased or sold plants to update their plant data.

Companies who participated in either v1 or v2 and have no significant changes to their operations **may not** need to provide data for v3.0. This will be determined once a participation directory is collected.



WHY SHOULD YOU PARTICIPATE?

- EPDs are required in LEED v4 and other standards.
 You can produce product specific EPDs but they are expensive and time consuming. The NRMCA Industry-Wide EPD is cost effective to NRMCA members.
- Companies must provide data to the Industry-Wide EPD in order to use the EPD for submittals.
- Concrete contributes significantly to LEED v4 and EPDs help design teams meet LEED certification criteria.
- By participating in the NRMCA Industry-Wide EPD, you can demonstrate leadership in environmental stewardship.
- You will provide an opporunity for your company to compete in the green building marketplace.

Important Details

- Fees: \$50 per plant for NRMCA members. \$250 per plant for non-NRMCA members.
- Only those producers who provide data for the Industry-Wide EPD can be listed and be eligible to use the document for a LEED submittals.
- Any data you provide will remain completely confidential.
